Spring City Municipal Canvass Board announces the official result, after a requested recount as follows:

There were 23 Write In votes and a total of 762 Votes Cast for council seats.

Due to a tie on the first Canvass, Candidate Kimberly Stewart requested a recount which was held on November 26, 2007 at the Sanpete County Court House by the Sanpete County Clerk's office. The results were the same as the first Canvass. Notice was given to canvass the votes on Monday November 26th, 2007 at 5:00 p.m. at Spring City Hall.

According to state statue 20A-1-304 a tie is determined by lot. Spring City canvassing board and election officer tossed a coin. Kimberly Stewart was chosen to call the coin toss in the air, she chose heads. The coin landed on tails. Councilman Boyd Mickel will retain his council seat for the next 4 years.
